MIDLAND FOOD DRIVE - THANK YOU!

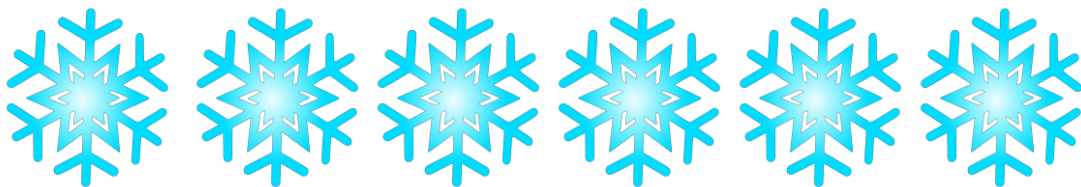
