Dear Midland Mustang Families,

Sometimes our families need some additional support, beyond our kids' education. We have access to many resources that may be of interest to you.

First, is your family living in any of these situations: In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation; in a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station; or doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship? If so, your school age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Next, have you ever found the need for community resources due to a crisis, lack of basic needs, Education and Employment Needs, Family and Parenting Services or Housing Issues? Our school has an exhaustive list of Franklin Pierce Community Resources which has been provided by Franklin Pierce Youth Fist. A complete list of community services is posted in our front entry.

Our school counselor, Mrs. Hagos, is an excellent resource if your family needs support. Our office staff, Mrs. Roberts and Mrs. Wright, will also be happy to assist you with connecting to resources which may be helpful to you. Please do not hesitate to contact us!
