Registration for the 2017-2018 school year begins Monday, March 27th. We will be registering only new kindergarten through grade 5 students who live within our attendance boundaries, or have daycare in our area. Current students are automatically enrolled for next year, with the exception of overload students who will return to their home schools for 2017-2018. Enrollees must provide a copy of your child's birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence. To be eligible for kindergarten, children must be five years of age by August 31, 2017. Daily registration hours are from 8:30 to 3:30 in our school office. You can pick up a registration packet on or after March 27th. On-line registration will be available at www.fpschools.org.
