2- student is approaching mastery of grade level standard OR grade level standards are still being taught and mastered

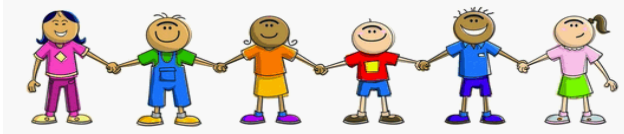
1- Student is far below mastery of the grade level standard
