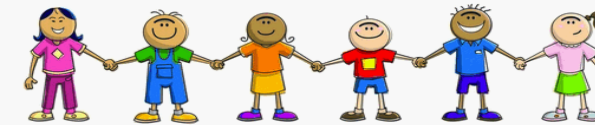

Registration for NEW students for the 2017-2018 school year has begun.

At this time, we are taking registration only for those children who live within our attendance boundaries, or have daycare in our area. Enrollees must provide a copy of their child's birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of residence. To be eligible for kindergarten, children must be five years of age by August 31, 2017.

If you live outside of the Franklin Pierce district please request your home district to submit your Choice Transfer form to our office as soon as possible, but no later than May 31st, in order to be considered for enrollment for next year.

If your child attended Midland on a within district transfer, please complete and submit the electronic Within District Transfer Request form (now available at our website http://www.fpschools.org/for_parents/RegistrationandTransfer) by May 31st in order to be considered for enrollment for the 2017-2018 school year.

Daycare forms are also due May 31st.
