Out of District – Students who live outside the FP Schools boundaries and currently attend Midland will be re-enrolled upon receipt of an electronic Choice Transfer from the school district in which you reside.

In-District – If your child attends Midland on a release from one of the other elementary schools in our district, the With-In District Student Transfer form is available on the FP website under "Parents" "Registration & Transfers".

Day Care – If your child is at Midland due to day care, the Day Care Verification form is also due on May 31st. The form is available on the FP website and at our office.
